

Cement Safety

Protect Your Skin and Eyes



Cement (wet or dry) is **caustic** to your skin and eyes. It can cause **burns, rashes, and irritations**. Protect your skin and eyes by doing the following:

- **Protect your hands with well-fitted gloves when mixing and applying. Avoid allowing cement to enter inside the glove.**
- **Do not use cotton or leather gloves. Use butyl, nitrile, or other approved glove. Refer to the cement material safety data sheet (MSDS) for selecting proper glove.**
- **Avoid allowing cement to saturate your gloves and clothing. Wash contaminated gloves and clothing and allow gloves and clothing to dry before using.**
- **Wear approved eye protection at all times.**
- **Wash your hands and other skin area that has come into contact with the cement.**
