Always wear your seatbelt!

If forklift begins to tip over:

- Stay in the seat- do not attempt to jump clear.
- Hold on tightly to the steering wheel and brace yourself against the seat.
- Keep body inside the seat and frame area and lean in the opposite direction of the turnover.
