

ROOF and RIB SCALING



- **Always** pry up, not down, when scaling a mine roof and use the strength of your legs.
- **Always** check and sound the roof and rib areas.
- **Always** work in areas where the roof is supported. Never go inby unsupported roof areas.
- **Always** follow your roof control plan.
- **Always** survey the area for hazards.
- **Always** position or hold the scaling bar so that it is between you and the rib when scaling rib areas.
- **Always** use a scaling bar of correct length.
